Cancellations

Cancellations need to be notified the day before a class is scheduled, otherwise it may be considered a no-show and lost (or removed from a package). Arriving more than **20 minutes**

late to class without previous notice is considered a late cancellation and can result in a loss of the class.

These cases **don't apply to technical problems** outside of the learner or the teacher's control (like electricity or broadband outages), unless happening repeatedly or suspected of it being used as an excuse with deceptive intent.
